"Beanery" Museum Closed

To Be Relocated to Railroad Museum At the invitation of the Board of Directors of the ND State Railroad Museum, the Directors of the Mandan Historical Society voted in August to cease operations at the Heritage Park location in downtown Mandan, and relocate it to the relocated Steele railroad building to be added to the Railroad Museum grounds in November 2011.

Artifacts and Society's records are currently in storage. The 1920 - 1969 issues of the Mandan Pioneer Newspaper were relocated to the Beanery's basement.
